#### MATTHEW 11: 2-11

In the Gospel from Matthew, John the Baptist was in prison and would be shortly executed by King Herod the Tetrarch. He wanted to know that his life's work had not been in vain. His mission was to announce the coming of the Messiah and the arrival of the Kingdom of God. It was his task to go before Jesus Christ and announce the Way of the Lord. John sent a message to Jesus, "Are you the one who is to come, or have we got to wait for someone else"? Jesus reassures John and sends the message, "Go back and tell John what you hear and see; the blind see again, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear, the dead are raised to life and the Good News is proclaimed to the poor; and happy is the man who does not lose faith in me". John would have recognised the signs in the prophecies of the Old Testament of the coming of the Messiah. Jesus urged John not to lose faith in Him.

We must not lose faith. We are the people of joy. A miserable Christian is a contradiction in terms. The Christian message is called the Gospel or Good News and is the announcement of joy for all people. We know Jesus Christ. We know that God loved the world so much that He sent His only Son to be the means of our salvation. God is total love and wishes every human being to achieve salvation through His Son.
