#### MATTHEW 5:17-37

In the Gospel from Matthew, Jesus tells us, “If your virtue goes no deeper than that of the scribes and Pharisees, you will never get into the kingdom of heaven”. The scribes and Pharisees believed that you could only be reconciled to God through the adherence to external rules and regulations, but their hearts were cold. They were unable to let the love of God enter their hearts through His Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ. Jesus reminds His disciples and us that He did not come into the world to abolish the Law or the Prophets. He came into the world not to abolish but to complete them.

Jesus Christ, the Second Person of the Holy Trinity is the fulfilment of the Prophets and the Law. He sets us a much higher standard than the Law. He demands that ‘we love one another as I have loved you’.

Jesus tells us that if something is causing us to sin: pornography, the internet, bad company, alcohol, drugs, violence on TV – we need to remove it from our lives. If we do not remove it from our lives, it will harm and destroy our relationship with God. It could even cost us our eternal life with God.

We are all sinners and in need of God’s love and mercy. We need the necessary graces to love others as Jesus loves us. We need the support of our community; we need the blessings of Grace received through the Catholic Church. This is why we gather as a community on Sunday to celebrate the Holy Mass. At the Mass, we are fed with the Word of God, and we are fed with the Holy Eucharist – the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ. At the Mass, we receive the welcome and support of the whole community. At the Mass, we are affirmed in our faith.
