JOHN 4:5-42

In the Gospel from St John, Jesus goes to a Samaritan town and meets a woman at Jacob's well. The woman was a Samaritan and was living with a man that was not her husband and had been married to five different men. No self-respecting Jew would go anywhere near her — she was ritually unclean.

Jesus asks her for a drink of water. The woman is confused and does not understand who this man is who is asking her for water. Jesus challenges the woman, 'If you only knew what God is offering and who it is that is saying: Give me a drink, you would have been the one to ask, and He would have given you living water'. Jesus continues, 'Whoever drinks this water will get thirsty again; but anyone who drinks the water I shall give will never be thirsty again: the water I shall give will turn into a spring inside him, welling up to eternal life'.

Jesus is the water of eternal life. Through His passion, death, and resurrection, we are reborn in the water of Baptism. Through the Sacrament of Baptism, we become temples of the Holy Spirit; we become members of the Body of Christ – His Church; we become adopted sons and daughters of God the Father. In Baptism, we enter the very life of the Blessed Trinity: The Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is the living water welling up from Christ crucified as its source and is welling us up to eternal life. The Holy Spirit is the source of the work of sanctification in our lives.

Jesus declares to the woman that He is the Christ – the Messiah. She gives Jesus her faith and receives the gift of the Holy Spirit. She receives the gift of living water.
