JOHN 20:1-9

In the Gospel from John, Mary of Magdala goes to the tomb and finds it empty. She runs to Peter and John and tells them: 'They have taken the Lord out of the tomb'. It was Peter who goes into the tomb and understands that Jesus must rise from the dead. Happy Easter, Christ is Risen! He is truly risen! Alleluia! Alleluia!
