MARK 1:29-39

This is the first Sunday of Lent. In the Gospel from Mark, 'the Spirit drove Jesus out into the wilderness for forty days. In Lent, we are invited through acts of prayer, fasting and charity to join Jesus in the desert. As Jesus was tempted by Satan, we are also tempted to ignore the opportunity of developing our relationship with Jesus Christ and to increase in holiness during this period. The Stations of the Cross will be held each Friday evening at 7.00 pm. There is Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament from 11.00 am to 1.00 pm each Saturday.

We pray to increase our love of God, and love of our neighbour. In this way we open the door to allow the person of Jesus Christ to enter our hearts, souls, and minds. As we enter the desert of Lent, as the angels looked after Jesus, Jesus looks after us. He feeds and nourishes us with Himself, the Holy Eucharist: The Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. United with Jesus, we can proclaim the Good News from God. The Good News is that through our baptism, we are redeemed by the Cross of Jesus Christ, we are saved from sin and are granted eternal life.
