MATTHEW 5:38:48

In today's Gospel from Matthew, Jesus tells us that we are to 'offer the wicked man no resistance'. If we are hit on the right cheek, we are to offer our left cheek. If somebody takes our tunic, we are to give him our cloak as well. If anyone orders us to go one-mile, we must go two-miles. We are not to turn away those in need. Then comes the big ask: 'I say to you: love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you.' We will, then, 'be children of our Father in heaven.

God is total and perfect love. There are no limits to God's mercy. There are no tests by which we are to limit our obligation of love. As St Paul tells us: 'Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, and endures all things.' All Christians are called to the fullness of Christian life and to the perfection of love. Jesus acknowledged the Ten Commandments but also showed the power of the Holy Spirit at work in every word of God's Commandments. Jesus unfolded all the demands of the Commandments through the central demand by God to love. On the cross on Calvary, at His crucifixion, Jesus rather than condemning those who tortured him, simply said 'forgive them for they do not know what they do'.

Jesus tells us to be perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect and to be merciful, even as your Father is merciful. He says, "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another'.

Is it possible to love as God loves? Is it possible to be perfect as our heavenly Father is perfect? We can only imitate God by entering the very life of God. We can only imitate God by participating in the very life of The Blessed Trinity. The Blessed Trinity is the perfect relationship of love between God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. How do we enter the life of The Blessed Trinity? We enter the life of The Blessed Trinity through prayer, through acts of love especially to those in need; and by listening to the Word of God. We enter the life of the Blessed Trinity through the reception of the sacraments, and most especially, the Holy Eucharist, the Bread of Heaven: the body and blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ.
