LUKE 2:16-21

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, The Holy Mother of God. We celebrate that Mary was truly the Mother of Jesus. Jesus is truly God. Mary is, therefore, the Mother of God.

In the Gospel from Luke, we are given an account of the visitation of the shepherds to the Holy Family. The angel of the Lord had appeared to the shepherds and told them, 'Do not be afraid. Listen, I bring you news of great joy, a joy to be shared by the whole people. Today in the town of David a saviour has been born to you; He is Christ the Lord. And here is a sign for you, you will find a baby wrapped in swaddling clothes and lying in a manger.' The shepherds hurried to Bethlehem and found the baby lying in a manger. Having seen the baby, the shepherds went back glorifying and praising God. The shepherds were the first to evangelize and proclaim the Good News. Mary treasured all these things and pondered them in her heart.

Mary was proclaimed Mother of God by the Church at the Council of Ephesus in 431 AD. Jesus Christ had to be fully God and fully human. It is only by being fully God and fully human in one person that His death on a cross brought about our salvation. He had to be fully human to experience the pain and suffering of His crucifixion. He had to be fully God in order that His sacrifice on the cross could bring about the forgiveness of all sin. Mary gave Jesus His humanity.

Mary's greatness does not, however, depend on her Motherhood of God. Her greatness lies in her perfect faith and obedience to the will of God in her life. Mary is the model of all discipleship. Mary always leads us to her Son.
