JOHN 10:11-18

This is the Fourth Sunday of Easter. Today is also known as Good Shepherd or Vocation Sunday. In the Gospel from John, Jesus tells us: 'I am the Good Shepherd: The Good Shepherd is one who lays down his life for his sheep'. Jesus laid down His life and gave Himself up to death on a cross for His sheep. Jesus tells us: 'I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father'. Jesus invites us to a knowledge and love of Him that reflects the love of the Blessed Trinity: a reflection of the love between Jesus and His Father in the Holy Spirit. Jesus tells us: 'there are other sheep I have that are not of this fold, and these I have to lead as well'. God's offer of salvation through Jesus Christ is to the whole of humanity, regardless of race, gender, or creed. Jesus excludes nobody from the redeeming sacrifice of His love through His death on the Cross. Jesus tells us that He laid down His life 'of my own free will'. Jesus' death is the living proof that 'the greatest love a person can show is to give one's life for one's friend'. This is the proof that Jesus is truly the Good Shepherd. We are encouraged to consider the vocation of Priesthood this Sunday. A priest is called to serve God and to give pastoral care and leadership to a community. The Church needs priests. Pray that those called will have the courage and love to serve God and others in this special ministry.
