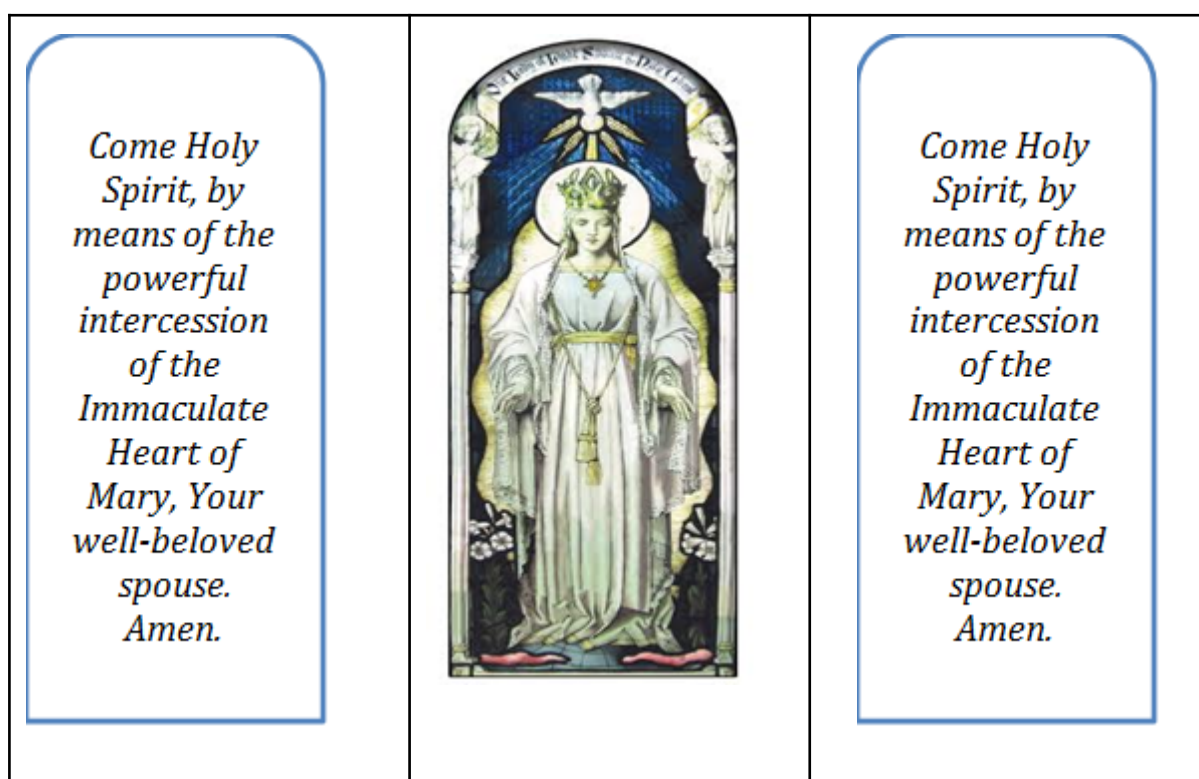

MARK 6:30-34 In the Gospel from Mark, Jesus took His disciples in a boat to a lonely place in order that they may rest following their work of announcing the Kingdom of God. But the people saw them going and followed them. As they step ashore, Jesus sees a large crowd waiting for them. Jesus takes pity on them because they were like sheep without a shepherd, and He sets Himself to teach them at some length. Jesus Christ is the faithful shepherd who loves and cares for His flock. He is the one, who will leave the ninety-nine sheep and go and find the one lost sheep. He is the one, who will lay down His life for His flock.
