LUKE: 18:9-14

In the Gospel from Luke, Jesus gives us a lesson on our attitude to God in prayer. He gives us the example of the proud Pharisee and the humble tax collector. The Pharisee judges himself according to the Law. He had kept all the requirements of the Law and was therefore perfect. He was praying to himself and not to God. He preferred to look at himself in a mirror rather than lift his eyes and heart to God. His real problem was his loved of self and pride. His heart was on his own accomplishments. He had failed to understand the commandment to 'Love the Lord your God, with your whole heart, mind and body, and your neighbour as yourself'. He has complete contempt for the tax collector in the temple.

The tax collector recognised his sinfulness before God. He had the humility in his heart to acknowledge his place before God almighty. He stood far off and would not even lift his eyes to heaven but beat his breast. His prayer was very brief, not long like that of the Pharisee: "God be merciful to me a sinner". He did not judge himself against the Law but the commandment: to love God and his neighbour. Jesus tells us that the tax collector 'went home again at rights with God; the other did not'.
