MATTHEW 28:16-20

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity – we celebrate the “Feast of God”: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. In the Gospel from Matthew, Jesus commanded His apostles to ‘Go, therefore, make disciples of all the nations; baptise them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teach them to observe all the commands I gave you. And know that I am with you always; yes, to the end of time’.

In Baptism, we are born into new life and become adopted sons and daughters of the Father; we become members of the body of Christ and temples of the Holy Spirit. The Sacrament of Baptism signifies and brings about death to sin and entry into the life of the Most Holy Trinity. We are made in the image of God and are destined to spend our eternal future in the very life of God – the Holy Trinity.

The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and of Christian life. The Holy Trinity is one God and in this one God there are three Divine Persons, God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit in a relationship of total love. God is love. The Holy Trinity is the source of all love that we experience both in this life and the next. The whole Christian life is a communion with each of the divine persons, without in any way separating them. Everyone who glorifies the Father does so through the Son in the Holy Spirit; everyone who follows Christ does so because the Father draws them, and the Spirit moves them. The ultimate end of the whole divine economy is the entry of humanity into the perfect unity of the Blessed Trinity. This is the state that we call heaven. In the words of St Athanasius, ‘Jesus Christ became man in order that we may become God’.
