#### MATTHEW 5:1-12

In today's Gospel, we are presented with the Beatitudes. They are nice words but what do they mean? God gave the Ten Commandments to the Jewish people on Mount Sinai. He gave His Chosen People the Written Law. Jesus came not to abolish the Law but to fulfil it through His Birth, Death, and Resurrection. Jesus gave His disciples and us the Beatitudes. The Beatitudes are at the heart of Jesus' preaching. Jesus gave us the new law 'to love one another as I have loved you.' The Beatitudes depict the countenance of Jesus Christ and His love. They express our Christian vocation; they give us the characteristics of the Christian life; they sustain us in times of difficulty, they proclaim the blessings of Christ, and the promises of the Kingdom of God. The Beatitudes reveal the goal of human existence; the ultimate end of human endeavour: to be called by God to His likeness and share in His own beatitude.

To see the Beatitudes is to see Christ. To live the Beatitudes is to enter into the very life of the Blessed Trinity. A community of pure love in the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit in one God. How do we obtain the graces necessary to live the Beatitudes? We attain these graces through prayer, through love shown to others in need, through reading Holy Scripture, through the reception of the Sacraments and most especially the Holy Eucharist – the Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ.
