MATTHEW 22:34-40

In the Gospel from Matthew, we are given a further account of the Pharisees trying once again to catch Jesus out in order that they could publicly condemn Him. For the devout Jew all the commandments were to be kept with equal care. If Jesus gave greater significance to one commandment over another, they would be able to incense the people against Him. Jesus goes beyond the extent of the question put to Him and joins the greatest and the first commandment to a second, that of love of neighbour. Jesus tells the Pharisees that the entire law and the preaching of the prophets are derived and sourced from this double commandment.

What does the message of this Gospel mean to us today? We are to love the Lord Our God with all our hearts, with all our souls and with all our minds. We are to love others as we love ourselves. Each one of us will be judged at the end of our lives on these two commandments. Have we put God first in our lives? Have we loved and treated others fairly, partly those who are disadvantaged to us: the poor, the sick, the lonely and the homeless? Our eternal destination relies on the responses to these two questions.

God loved us so much that He sent His only son in to the world to die on the cross and be the Sacrifice for our sins. He sent His only Son to reconcile the world to Himself. We are expected to respond to God's love and live a life of love in return. A life based on the Love of God and love of others. We cannot achieve a life of love without the help and grace of God. In the Holy Mass, we receive the Holy Eucharist, the body and blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ. The Eucharist gives us the spiritual graces to love God and others in our lives.
