MARK 14:12-16, 22-26

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ or Corpus Christi. We celebrate the Holy Eucharist: The Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ made present in the Holy Mass and reserved in the church tabernacle. Vatican II declared that the Eucharist is “the source and summit of the Christian life”. All the sacraments make possible a contact with the Risen Christ. However, in the Holy Eucharist we actually behold the bodily and spiritual presence of Christ Himself. The Holy Eucharist is truly, really, and substantially the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

In the Gospel from Mark, Jesus instructed His disciples to make the necessary preparations to celebrate the Feast of Passover. At the Passover meal, Jesus ‘took some bread, and when He had said the blessing, He broke it and gave it to them. “Take it”, He said “this is my body”. Then He took a cup, and when He had returned thanks, He gave it to them, and all drank from it, and He said to them, “This is my blood, the blood of the covenant, which is to be poured out for many”.

The actions and words of Jesus expressed at this Passover meal, communicate the establishment of the New Covenant. The New Covenant is the sacrifice of Jesus through the offering of His body and blood in anticipation of His passion and death.

At the Holy Mass, during the Eucharistic Prayer, the Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ is made present. All the barriers of time and space are lifted during the Mass. The Council of Trent states: ‘under the consecrated form of bread and wine Christ Himself, living and glorious, is present in a true, real, and substantial manner: His body and Blood with His soul and His divinity. The sacrifice of Christ on the Cross and the sacrifice of the Eucharist are one single sacrifice.

We can say not only that each of us receives Christ in Holy Communion, but also that Christ receives each of us. He feeds and nourishes us in Holy Communion. Each time we receive Holy Communion, we are changed by Christ. We are drawn nearer to Christ and enter a deeper friendship with Him. Christ incrementally transforms us into the people that God wishes us to be in this life and for all eternity.
