MATTHEW 13:33-37

Today we celebrate the First Sunday of Advent. What is Advent and what are we celebrating?

The word Advent comes from the Latin word *Adventus*, which means 'coming'. It is a period of expectant waiting for the Lord. It is a period of preparation for the celebration of the birth of Our Lord Jesus Christ at Christmas, and a reminder that Jesus will return in glory at the end of time. This is an opportunity to invite Jesus to come into our hearts and our souls.

In the Gospel from St Mark, Jesus tells us to 'Be on your guard, stay awake, because you never know when the time will come'. No one, except the Father, knows the time of the Second Coming of Jesus Christ. Jesus has told us that there will be a Second Coming. We pray at each Mass for the Lord to return at the Second Coming. It is a reality of our faith. I believe that Jesus is also encouraging us to be constantly prepared for our personal meeting with Christ at the end of our lives.

It is a tradition in the Church that the Priest wears purple vestments in Advent. The colour purple signifies repentance and renewal of our relationship with God. We should, therefore, use the opportunities given to us in Advent to open our lives to Jesus, in order that we may grow into a deeper and more meaningful relationship with Him. The Advent wreath and candles are also a great tradition at this time of year. The first candle is lit today on the First Sunday in Advent and is called the 'Candle of Hope.' This is the hope founded in the promises of our faith. The hope in a God who loves us and who sent His Only Son to redeem us.
