Mark 12:28-34 In the Gospel from Mark, Jesus gives us the summary of the Law, 'Listen, Israel, the Lord our God is the one Lord, and you must love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind and with all your strength, and you must love your neighbour as yourself.'

Why is love so important? Love is important because God is love. God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit live in a perfect relationship of love. Three persons in one being. The Blessed Trinity is the source of all the love we will experience in this life and the next. God's nature is pure love. If we are to be in relationship with God, we must be people of love. If we are not people of love, we cannot be in relationship with God. The love that this Gospel refers to is not sentimental love. Jesus refers to sacrificial love or agape. This love is not easy. This love always has a price to pay. This love involves putting other people before our own needs. It is the love that a parent has for their child. It is the love that Jesus gave when He endured the sufferings of the cross for our sake. Jesus was without sin, but He took the sins of the world unto himself in order to reconcile humanity with God.

How do we love this way? We love this way through prayer; through the practice of sacrificial love by helping others in need, especially those we find difficult to love; through reading and listening to the Gospels, where the person of Jesus Christ speaks to us and tells us how to love; by receiving the sacraments, and finally we love this way through the reception of the Blessed Sacrament – the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ. He gives us himself in the Holy Eucharist in order that we may love as He loves us.
