Matthew 16:21-27

In today's Gospel from Matthew, we have the first prophecy of the Passion. Jesus told His disciples that 'He was destined to go to Jerusalem and suffer grievously at the hands of the elders and chief priests and scribes, to be put to death and to be raised up on the third day.'

Peter challenged Jesus and said that 'this must not happen to you.' He understood that Jesus was the Messiah, but his expectations were of kingship, glory, and triumph in worldly terms. He did not understand that the Messiah had to suffer and die for others. He did not understand that Jesus would be glorified on a Cross. Jesus is the suffering Messiah. Jesus responded to Peter: 'Get behind me, Satan! You are an obstacle in my path, because the way you think is not God's way but man's.'

Jesus tells us and His disciples: 'If anyone wants to be a follower of mine, let him renounce himself and take up his cross and follow me.'

We are Christians and disciples of Jesus Christ. We follow Jesus to the Cross, and to the Resurrection. There can be no Resurrection without the Cross. We all experience disappointments, hurt, pain and suffering at some time in our lives. If our lives were perfectly happy and without any difficulties, we would be frauds and could not be called followers of Christ. As Christians, when we face suffering, we should always try to offer up and unite our suffering with the Passion of Christ. In this way, our suffering has meaning for our salvation and for the redemption of the world.
