JOHN 3:16-18

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity – we celebrate the “Feast of God”: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of the Christian faith and of Christian life.

In the Gospel from John, Jesus told Nicodemus that, ‘God loved the world so much that He gave His Only Son’. Jesus Christ entered into humanity through the Blessed Virgin Mary to be the perfect sacrifice for our sins. Following His death, Resurrection and Ascension into heaven, the Father send the Holy Spirit to establish the Church on earth. Jesus Christ is now seated at the right-hand of the Father in heaven and will return at the end of time in judgement and glory.

We enter into the life of the Blessed Trinity through our baptism. In Baptism, we are born into new life and become adopted sons and daughters of the Father; we become members of the Body of Christ – His Church; and temples of the Holy Spirit. The Sacrament of Baptism signifies and actually brings about death to sin and entry into the life of the Most Holy Trinity. We are made in the image of God and are destined to spend our eternal future in the very life of God – the Holy Trinity. In the words of St Athanasius, ‘Jesus Christ became man in order that we may become God’.
