#### MATTHEW 5:13-16

In today's Gospel from Matthew, Jesus tells his disciples: 'You are the salt of the earth', 'You are the light of the world'.

Through our Baptism, we became disciples of Jesus Christ, temples of the Holy Spirit, members of the Body of Christ, and adopted Sons and Daughters of God. At our Baptism, we were given a lighted candle from the Easter Paschal Candle, with the following words: 'Receive the light of Christ'. The Paschal Candle is blessed and lit at the Easter Vigil, the most sacred service in the Church, where we celebrate the Resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ and the redemption of the world. At our Baptism, we are given the gift of faith and the indwelling of the Holy Spirit to be a light to the world. This world needs our witness. We are not to hide our faith or make it a private and personal possession. We are called to witness our faith to all we meet.

How do we witness our faith? We witness our faith by obeying the Lord's command, 'to love one another as I have loved you'. We witness our faith through living the Beatitudes. The Beatitudes describe for us what it means to be the earth's salt and the world's light. Can we do this on our own? No - we need the support of our community; we need the blessings of Grace received through the Catholic Church. This is why we gather as a community on Sunday to celebrate the Holy Mass. At the Mass, we are fed with the Word of God, and we are fed with the Holy Eucharist – the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ. At the Mass, we receive the welcome and support of the whole community and are affirmed in our faith. It is at the Mass that we receive the blessings and graces to be disciples of Jesus Christ, and a light to the whole world.
