### **MATTHEW 23: 1-12**

In the Gospel from Matthew, Jesus reprimanded the scribes and the Pharisees. Why is He being so severe with the religious leaders?

These men had studied scripture and would have known many of the Old Testament Books by memory. They would have known in detail the Word of God. These men would have presided at many liturgies in synagogues and the Temple. They would have spent long periods in prayer. They had given so much but failed to give their hearts to God. Jesus called them hypocrites. This is a Latin word which means actor. The scribes and Pharisees acted the part of 'the holy men'. They were the saddest of people. Their intentions may have been worthy, but they failed God, themselves, and others in their lives. They had failed to understand that God is a God of total love and not a God of rules and regulations. They had failed to recognise God incarnate in the person of Jesus Christ.

What does this Gospel mean to us today?

This Gospel is a warning to people in positions of authority or influence within the Church or a Christian community. Jesus judges each person by the motives of their hearts. We must give our hearts completely to God. We must be genuine in our faith. We must approach God with humility and love. We must love our neighbour. Jesus had summarised all the commandments: 'To love the Lord your God with all your heart, mind and strength; and to love your neighbour as yourself'. Jesus gave us His new commandment: 'To love one another as I have loved you'.

At the end of our lives, we take only one thing with us into the next world. That one thing is love. The love we have given to God and others. The love we have received from others. St Paul tells us that only love is eternal. There is no other currency in heaven.
