JOHN 20: 19-31

This is the Second Sunday of Easter. It is also known as Divine Mercy Sunday. In the Gospel from John, the disciples were hiding in a locked room in fear from the Jews. Jesus came and stood among them. He said to them, "Peace be with you" and showed them His hands and His side. The disciples were full of joy. Jesus then breathed on them and said: 'Receive the Holy Spirit. For those whose sins you forgive, they are forgiven; for those whose sins you retain, they are retained'. The disciples were transformed from disciples to apostles. They were transformed from students of Jesus to ambassadors of Jesus. It was now their role to continue Christ's ministry on earth. Jesus breathed upon them the Holy Spirit. Through the Holy Spirit they received the power of the Sacraments. They were given the authority to act in the person of Jesus Christ.

Thomas was not present at the time and refused to believe that Jesus had risen from the dead. Jesus returned and spoke to Thomas telling him to "Put your finger here; look, here are my hands. Give me your hand; put it into my side. Doubt no longer". Thomas replied with the wonderful proclamation of faith: "My Lord and my God"! Jesus replied to Thomas and to us: "You believe because you can see me. Happy are those who have not seen and yet believe". This message should fill each of us with joy. We are the ones who have not seen and yet believe. Jesus tells us that we are the happy ones.

Jesus Christ through His death and Resurrection has released an ocean of love and mercy upon the earth. This is the message of Divine Mercy Sunday. This is the message of Easter. Merciful Jesus, I place my trust in you.
