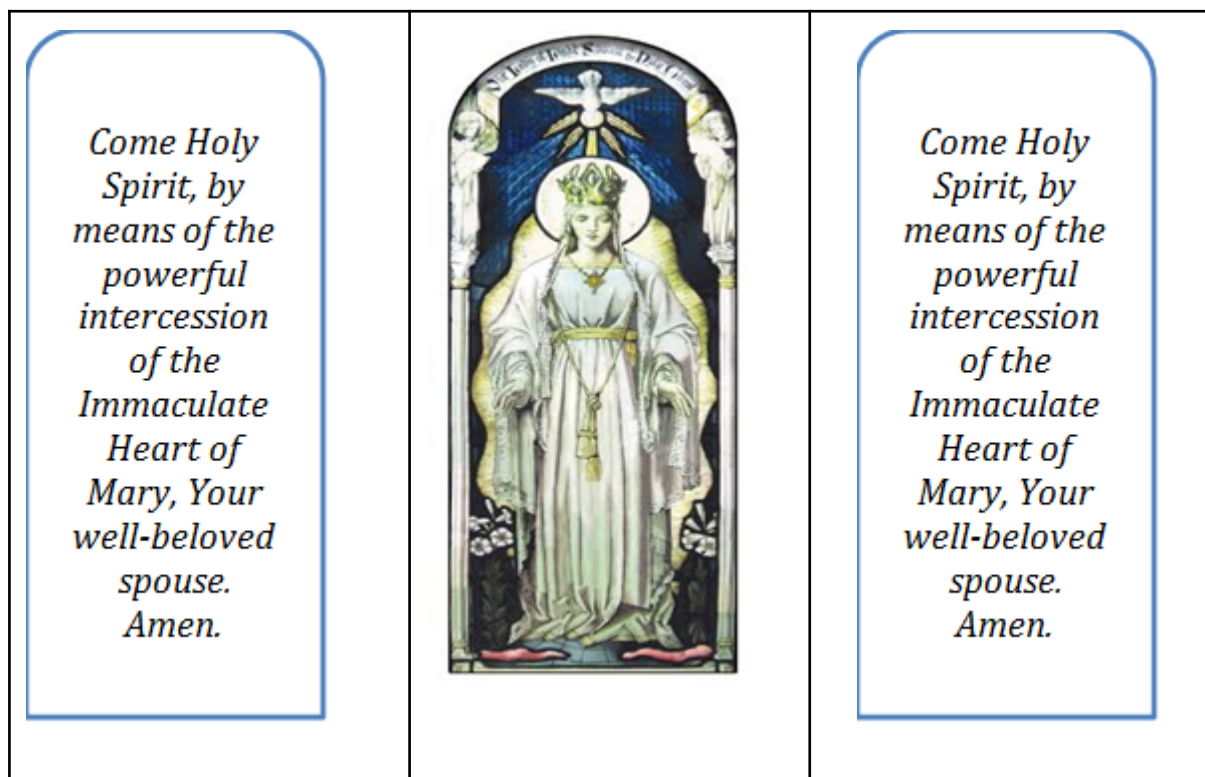

MARK 6:1-6: In the Gospel from Mark, Jesus visited His hometown with His disciples, and He taught in the synagogue. The people were amazed by His teaching but rejected Jesus. They could not accept that a man from His background could speak with such wisdom and authority.

In the words of the Prophet Isaiah, they had ears but could not hear.

They had eyes but could not see. They had no faith. They did not know Jesus at all. They were blinded by their familiarity. Jesus is not able to heal without faith. We can be blinded through our familiarity in our relationship with Jesus and His Church. We fail to appreciate the gift of our faith; we fail to appreciate the gift of our salvation. Following the Ascension of Jesus Christ into heaven, the Holy Spirit was sent forth by The Father, and through Our Lord Jesus Christ. Through the Holy Spirit the Church was born and was given the gift of the Sacraments. It is through the Sacraments that Jesus continues His healing ministry on earth. The greatest of the Sacraments is the Holy Eucharist: the Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ. This is the greatest gift Jesus could give us. It is the gift of Himself to feed and nourish our immortal souls. This is the greatest gift of healing and love. Do we really believe in the true presence? Does our familiarity with Holy Communion blind our faith in the gift of God Himself? Do we recognize God Himself in the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle when we enter a Church? Does our familiarity blind us from the truth?
