JOHN 20:19-31

In the Gospel from John, we are given an account of the post resurrection appearances of Jesus to His disciples. It was the evening of Sunday. Jesus came and stood among the disciples. His words were, "Peace be with you". Jesus replaces all our fears with the joy of the peace of His presence. He showed the disciples His hands and side as evidence of His crucifixion and death.

Jesus commands His disciples and us with the words, "As the Father sent me, so am I sending you". His ministry on earth is to continue through His disciples. This includes all baptised Christians. To be a Christian is to be a disciple of Jesus Christ. He then instituted the Sacrament of Holy Orders by breathing on the disciples, with the command, "Received the Holy Spirit. For those whose sins you forgive, they are forgiven; for those whose sins you retain, they are retained." Jesus is the source of the Holy Spirit. It is through the Holy Spirit; we are given the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Following Jesus' death and resurrection; there is no sin that cannot be forgiven with true repentance. A great ocean of love and mercy has been released through the perfect sacrifice of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

We finish with the witness of Thomas, who declared to Jesus, "My Lord and my God". Jesus speaks of those you believe but who have not seen His physical resurrection. Jesus speaks these words of encouragement to us. We are the generation of faith. Our faith gives us the hope in a God who loves us, and the certainty of the gift of eternal life.
