LUKE 5:1-11 In the Gospel from Luke, we are given witness to the calling of Peter and the Twelve Apostles by Jesus. Jesus tells them to 'Put out into deep water and pay out your nets for a catch'. Following the great catch of fish, Simon Peter falls at the knees of Jesus saying, 'Leave me, Lord; I am a sinful man'. Jesus calls Simon and the Twelve Apostles to follow Him. They all left everything behind and followed Him. Jesus called these men to follow Him in order to proclaim the Gospel.

At our Baptism, we became temples of the Holy Spirit. We became members of the Body of Christ. At our Baptism, we were anointed with the oil of Chrism and commissioned to proclaim the Gospel. God has prepared us for this Mission. The Gospel is the means of the salvation of the world. The Gospel is Jesus Christ born, died, and raised from the dead. He is the 'Lamb who takes away the sins of the world'. He has called each Baptised Christian to 'Put out into deep' and to proclaim His Holy Gospel. The future of humanity depends on our response.
