**Luke 3:10-18** In the Gospel from Luke, the people asked John the Baptist, “What must I do? He told them that they must treat people fairly and share their possessions with those in need. John declared, ‘I baptise you with water, but someone is coming, someone who is more powerful than I am, and I am not fit to undo the strap of His sandals; He will baptise you with the Holy Spirit and fire. Water signifies birth and the life given in the Holy Spirit. Fire symbolizes the transforming energy of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit was given to the Church at Pentecost. Each one of us has been given the Holy Spirit at our Baptism – we are ‘Temples of the Holy Spirit’.

This great gift of grace must have a transforming effect on our lives and on those we meet. We are to be people of joy and love. We are to rejoice! We are to tell others of the Good News of Jesus Christ. We are to show love to those less privileged than ourselves: the old, the lonely, the homeless, those without jobs. We must share with those who have nothing. We are to live our lives in the knowledge that we have been saved by Jesus Christ. The same Jesus Christ, we receive in the Holy Eucharist: The Body and Blood of Our Lord Jesus Christ.
