Apostles' Creed

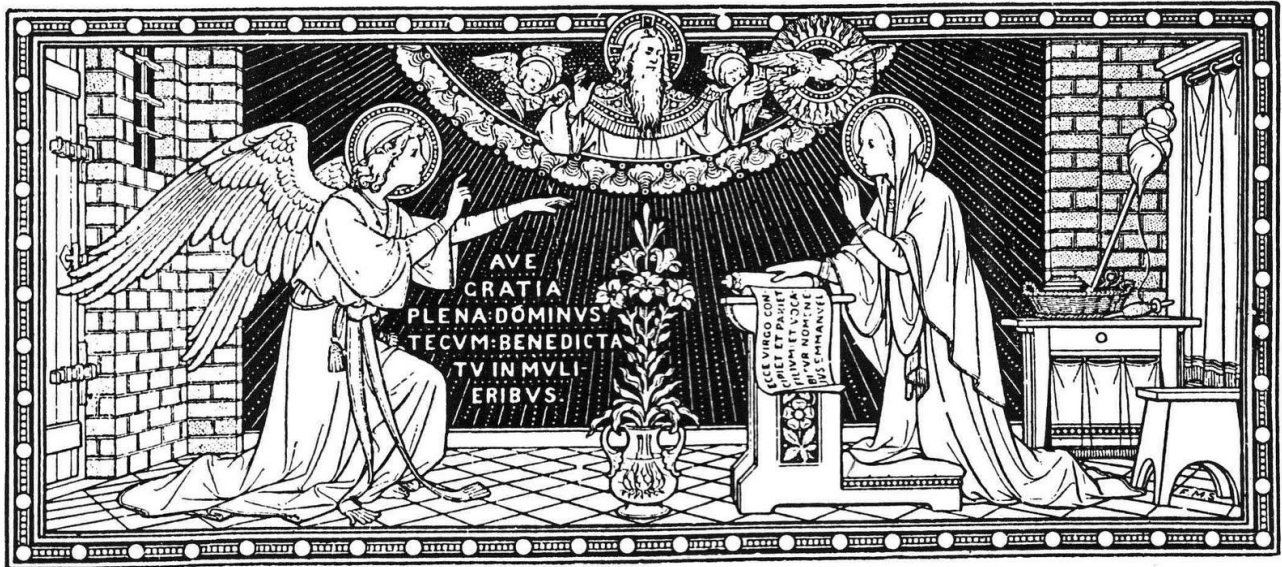

1 The Incarnation

2 The Visitation

3 The Birth of Jesus

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honour of Thy birth in the stable of Bethlehem. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for detachment from worldly things, contempt of riches, and the love of poverty. Amen.

4 The Presentation in the Temple

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honour of Thy Presentation in the Temple and of the purification of Mary. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for purity of body and soul. Amen.

5 The Finding of the Child Jesus in the Temple

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honour of Mary finding Thee in the Temple. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for the gift of true wisdom. Amen.

The Luminous Mysteries ~ Thursdays

1 The Baptism of the Lord

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this first decade in honour of Your Baptism in the Jordan. While John was baptising You, Your Father's voice was heard, saying, "This is my Beloved Son". By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for the grace to recognise in the person of Jesus the Love of the Father. Amen.

Come Holy Spirit, by means of the powerful intercession of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, Your well beloved spouse.

2 The Wedding Feast at Cana

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this second decade in honour of Your first public miracle – changing water into wine at Cana. Remaining in the background, your Mother Mary uses her maternal instinct to influence Your decision. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask that we may come to a deeper faith in You. Amen.

3 The Proclamation of the Kingdom

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this third decade in honour of Your proclamation of the coming of the Kingdom of God and Your call to Conversion. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for the grace of sincere repentance and conversion of heart. Amen.

4 The Transfiguration

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this fourth decade in honour of Your Transfiguration on Mount Tabor. As the Glory of the Godhead shone from Your Face, Your Father commanded the astonished Apostles to "listen to Him". By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for the grace to listen attentively to Your Word. Amen.

5 The Institution of the Eucharist

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this fifth decade in honour of You offering Your Body and Blood as food under the signs of bread and wine, and so testifying to Your Love for Humanity, for whose salvation You will offer Yourself in Sacrifice. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for a deeper appreciation of Your Love shown to us in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. Amen.

The Sorrowful Mysteries ~ Tuesdays & Fridays

1 The Agony in the Garden

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honour of Thy mortal Agony in the Garden of Olives. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for contrition for our sins. Amen.

2 The Scourging

3 The Crowning with Thorns

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honour of Thy being crowned with thorns. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for contempt of the spirit of the world. Amen.

4 The Carrying of the Cross

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honour of Thy carrying the Cross. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for patience in all our crosses. Amen.



5 The Crucifixion

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honour of Thy Crucifixion and ignominious death on Calvary. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for the conversion of sinners, the perseverance of the just and the relief of the souls in purgatory. Amen.

1 The Resurrection

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honour of Thy glorious Resurrection. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for love of God and fervour in His service. Amen.

2 The Ascension

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honour of Thy triumphant Ascension. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for an ardent desire for heaven, our true country. Amen.

3 The Descent of the Holy Spirit

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honour of the mystery of Pentecost. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for the coming of the Holy Spirit into our souls. Amen.



4 The Assumption of Our Lady

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honour of the Resurrection and triumphant Assumption of Thy Holy Mother into heaven. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for true devotion towards our Lady. Amen.

5 The Coronation of Our Lady

We offer Thee, O Lord Jesus, this decade in honour of the Coronation of Thy Holy Mother. By this mystery and through the intercession of Thy Holy Mother, we ask for perseverance in grace and the crown of heavenly glory. Amen.

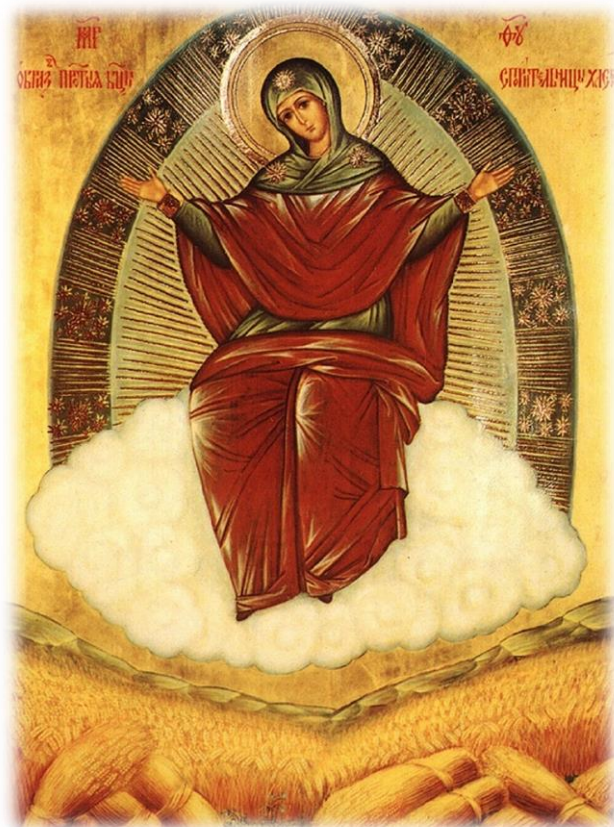

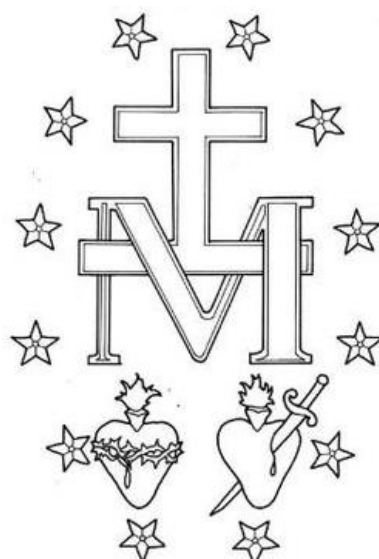
✠ That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.
