MARK 12:24-32

The readings this Sunday speak of the end of the world: the return of Jesus Christ in glory and in judgement. They speak of a time of testing and trials. They speak of the Parousia. They tell us to be watchful for the signs and to be ready for the Lord's return. In the Gospel from Mark, Jesus tells us that the time will come for His return. He tells us, "In those days, after the time of distress, the sun will be darkened, the moon will lose its brightness, the stars will come falling from heaven and the powers in the heavens will be shaken. And then they will see the Son of Man coming in the clouds with great power and glory".

Following the Ascension of Jesus Christ into heaven and the sending forth of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, humanity has been living in the time of the Church. This is the time of testing and waiting for the return of Jesus Christ. Death and sin have been defeated but evil is allowed to operate in the world until the Day of Judgement. We must remember that Jesus Christ is the Head of the Church. The Church is the Body of Christ. Christ dwells on earth in His Church. Since the Ascension of Our Lord Jesus Christ, God's plan has entered its fulfilment. We are already at 'the last hour'. Already the final age of the world is with us, and the renewal of the world is irrevocably under way. It is a time of the Holy Spirit and witness. It is a time of distress in which the Church will endure the trial of evil.

We have nothing to fear during this final stage of the history of the world. We live in the safe and secure in knowledge that our salvation is guaranteed by the death and resurrection of Our Lord Jesus Christ. The battle has been won! Our enemies and the evil forces of this world can hurt our bodies, but they cannot harm our immortal souls. We belong to Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ is the Lord of the Cosmos and of history. In the Eucharist, we pray to hasten Christ's return by saying to Him, 'Marana tha'! Our Lord Come! In the Holy Eucharist, Jesus Christ nourishes us with His Body and Blood to sustain us on our earthly journey to our eternal destination to spend eternity in the Glory of Heaven.
